

## Spetchley's Hidden History



## Suitable for Key Stage 2

Spetchley's history with the Berkeley family spans over 400 years. Starting at its initial purchase during the Tudor period, students will learn about the massive changes that affected Spetchley during the Battle of Worcester and the Victorian period. Finally students will learn about the impact that World War II had on Spetchley and its links to Winston Churchill.

The activity lasts 45 minutes and takes place in the Learning Centre. Working in teams students will use handling objects and photographs to find the answers to questions focused with the Gardens.

The activity is followed by free time in the Heritage Centre for students to learn more about Spetchley.
